- Review Classes offered:
 - Algebra I (Four classes)
 - Algebra II (Two classes)
 - Chemistry (Six classes)
 - Earth Science (Four classes)
 - French (One Class)
 - Geometry (Two classes)
 - Global History (Six classes)
 - Living Environment (Eight classes)
 - Physics (Four classes)
 - Spanish (Three Classes)
 - U.S. History (Four class)

- The District was able to use COVID Grant Funding to offer Regents Review free of charge.
- Classes met two nights per week for ninety minutes
- Each class met for a total of 10 sessions.
- The language classes met after school.
- There were 628 students enrolled in the review classes.

(Some of these students were enrolled in more than one class.)
