### Instructional Budget

- Significant Changes Include
  - Program Changes
    - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Math/Science Option
    - Coding K-12
    - Social Skills programs for HS CORE Program
  - Staffing
    - Added Coding Teacher at HS
    - Social Worker now in budget that was COVID funded
    - Other COVID funding ended, those are now fully in the budget including a nurse, psychologist, before and after school support programs
  - DECA Funding increased
  - Athletics (Further discussion next budget meeting)
    - Added 6 teams (coaches, uniforms, equipment, transportation, BOCES scheduling/referees)
    - Upgraded SSHS basement locker room
    - New equipment needed for increased participation in football
