Voter Qualifications Residents are qualified to vote if they are:

- > A citizen of the United States
 - > 18 years of age or older
- ➤ A resident of the District for at least 30 days prior to the election

Voting Eligibility

Residents are registered and eligible to vote if they:

- have previously registered and voted in a School District and/or a Public Library election within the last four calendar years, or
- have registered to vote with the Nassau County Board of Elections and have voted at least once in any local, State or National election within the last four calendar years, or
- have registered to vote with the School District prior to this election.

Absentee Ballots

Qualified registered voters can obtain applications for absentee ballots from the District Clerk, William H. Johnson Administration Building, 128 Shepherd Street, Rockville Centre, at least 7 days before the vote if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. Ballots for Military Personnel

Military personnel, along with their spouses and/or dependents, may register as a military voter in New York State.

On the Ballot

you will be asked to vote on:

- The 2022/2023 School District Budget
- The 2022/2023 Rockville Centre Public Library Budget
- The election of one (1) member of the Board of Education for three (3) year terms, and
- The election of two (2) members of the Library Board for three (3) year terms.

Procedures for Board of Education Candidacy

There will be one (1) Board of Education seats up for election on May 17, 2022.

- The term for a Board of Education member is three years.
- Petitions for Candidates to the Board of Education can be picked up at the Office of the District Clerk, William H. Johnson Administration Building, 128 Shepherd Street, Rockville Centre.
- Residents considering candidacy for an at-large seat on the Board of Education should be aware of the following:
 - ➤ The deadline to return Board Candidate petitions is Monday, April 18th at 5PM at the Office of the District Clerk, William H. Johnson Administration Building, 128 Shepherd Street, Rockville Centre.
 - ➤ A minimum of sixty (60) signatures is required on the petitions for each nominee.
 - ➤ Education Law Section 1528 requires that all candidates for election to a Board of Education must file sworn statements of campaign expenses to the District Clerk of the school district three times during the election process.
