What can I use to build my volcano?

Start with a small cup or water bottle to use as the base and find something to build around it.

You can use Legos, sticks, pebbles, toothpicks, tape, fabric, string, dirt, playdough, or any kind of craft materials you have at home.

How do I activate my volcano?

Ask an adult to help you gather these materials and complete this part of the project.

Ingredients:

- Baking Soda (1-2 spoonfuls the larger the cup, the more you will need)
- Dish Soap (just a few drops)
- White vinegar
- Food coloring/washable paint (optional)

Directions:

- Place baking soda on bottom of cup in the center of the volcano
- Pour a few drops of dish soap on top of the baking soda
- Add food coloring if you have some
- Pour the vinegar into the cup
