## School Improvement Bond and Capital Improvement Photos

Over the summer, School District staff and contractors worked tirelessly undertaking many Capital Improvement and Bond projects. At South Side High School the gym floors were stripped, repainted and refinished and the old bleachers were replaced with beautiful new customized ones. Installation of the lighting on the South Side High School field also began this summer. Bases for the light poles are in place and electricians are scheduled to start the wiring in the coming weeks. To determine how much drainage was needed for the new field, soil samples were taken from the High School field this summer. These samples will also provide us with valuable information needed in the engineering of the new extensions.

At South Side Middle School, the old surface of the track was removed and a brand new rubber surface has been installed and painted. Please feel free to stop by and give the track a test run/walk.

Aging boilers at Hewitt Elementary School were replaced with new, more energy efficient units. These new units will allow the school to operate in a more environmentally friendly manner while saving the District costs associated with running older models.

The cornice at Riverside Elementary School was given a fresh coat of paint and looks good as new.

We will continue to update you concerning your bond dollars at work as we move through what will be an exciting time in the Rockville Centre School District and Community.

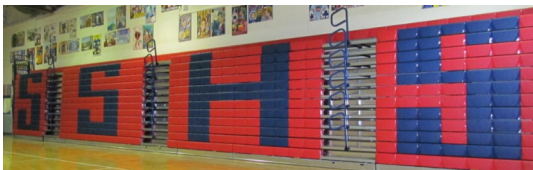

\* If you currently receive the STAR property tax exemption, you must register with the New York State Tax Department to continue receiving this exemption. The deadline to register is December 31, 2013. Seniors receiving the Enhanced STAR exemption do not need to register with the Tax Department, but must continue applying annually with their local assessor or sign up for the New York State Tax Department's Income Verification Program.
